## **Identifying and Writing Practice Gap Statement**

An effective practice gap statement clearly summarizes the state of current practice for care

providers/teams in a given setting as compared to the desired practice state for those same providers/teams. Clearly identifying a practice gap is critical to the development of your educational activity; it identifies your learning objectives and your potential learning assessment opportunities.
